Kill two birds with one drive: If you've got some flexibility, combine a business trip with a drive-away gig, where you make arrangements to drive somebody else's car for them; some of these gigs even come with a bit of pocket money. Hittheroad.ca has an "Available Cars" page, but local classifieds in your desired destination might get you there too. You can get where you need to for free or even up a few bucks, as long as you can meet the delivery deadline. Canadian routes often involve driving between a major east coast city and the west; say picking up in Toronto or Montreal and dropping off in Calgary or Vancouver, or vice versa. Many snowbirds pay drivers to bring their cars from big Canadian cities to Florida, Arizona and Southern California in the fall and back in the spring.

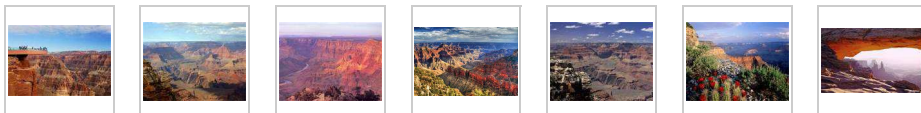
